GERMANY

Germany has established an official national federation under the name DTEV (Deutscher Tischeishockey Verband). In February 2019, they will organize their first Delegates Conference with elections to the Board of DTEV. The ITHF looks forward to having the DTEV as a full member with voting rights.

TOURNAMENT RULE 2.6 (proposal):

2.6: ITHF can decide to organize the World Club Championship (WCC).

2.6i: Players can only change clubs in two transfer windows, which is from 15th of December to 31st of January and from the Monday after the annual international championship in June (European or World Championships) to the 31st of August.

2.6ii: Players can only change club once every year.

2.6iii: When establishing a completely new club, only players from two clubs can change to this club in the same transfer window.

2.6iv: Players from a maximum of one club can change to the same club in the same transfer window - with the exception of Rule 2.6iii.

MONEY IN ITHF

It is important for the Executive Committee of ITHF to know whether ITHF should move in a direction with money from participants in the World Table Hockey Tour, membership fees or stay as now with no exact payment to ITHF.

Therefore, we ask the national federations to tell us your opinion.

If you are - more or less - satisfied with the present level of activity, ITHF does not need any money. The amount of payment to ITHF is related to the amount of wishes and expectations.

APPLICATIONS FOR ORGANIZING INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020, WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021 and WORLD CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP 2019 OR 2020

ITHF is asking organizers to send your application to host the European Championships 2020, World Championships 2021 or World Club Championship 2019 or 2020. In the application, we ask you to provide details about accommodation (hotels, hostels etc.), public transport and the venue of the tournament. We would also appreciate a draft of the time schedule of the tournament. Deadline for applications is **the 1st of March 2019**.
